

Sayyid Al-Hakeem renews call to manage Iraq's diversity, Christians voluntary return



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with the delegation of the Chaldean League on 4/3/2023 and they discussed the components of reality in Iraq, particularly the Christian component, which we consider to be a qualitative addition to Iraqi society and an integral part of Iraq's rose bouquet.
