

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraq abandons social and political sensitivity



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, head of Al-Hikma National Movement, visited the Sunni Endowment Directorate in Basrah the city of giving and good, at the Grand Basrah Mosque on Thursday, 4/5/2023, and met His Eminence, Sheik Mohammed Al-Mula, the Sunni Endowment Bureau and several scholars and religious men, sheiks, and dignitaries.
