

Sayyid Al-Hakeem discusses NSPA's institutionalization, provinces' needs from local government with Al-Abadi



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance (NSPA), met with Dr. Haider Al-Abadi, the head of the leadership council of the NSPA, during which they reviewed the outcomes of the local elections and expressed appreciation for the dedicated efforts of the alliance's personnel, particularly those involved in the election offices.
