

Sayyid Al-Hakeem discusses bilateral ties, Iraqi-regional political landscape with British Ambassador



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, discussed the political landscape in Iraq and the surrounding region, along with the bilateral ties between Iraq and Britain, and strategies to strengthen these ties for the mutual benefit of both nations, with the British Ambassador to Iraq, His Excellency Stephen Hickey on 4/1/2024.
