

Sayyid Al-Hakeem discusses Islamic Nation Challenges, especially Gaza crisis, with Sheikh Al-Khateeb



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with Sheikh Ali Al-Khateeb, the Deputy Head of the Supreme Islamic Shia Council in Lebanon, alongside the Lebanese Ambassador, Mr. Ali Al-Habhab, and discussed the formidable challenges confronting the Islamic nation, particularly the ongoing acts of brutality against the Palestinian people perpetrated by the Israeli military. Both their Eminences stressed the imperative of putting an end to this conflict, urging the international community to shoulder the responsibility for halting the bloodshed in Palestine.
