

Sayyid Al-Hakeem calls to elect speaker with genuine Sunni component support



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with the former Speaker of the Parliament, Mr. Mohammed Al-Halbousi on 29/2/2024, along with a delegation from Taqadum party leadership. His Eminence discussed the current political landscape and the conditions in the provinces following the establishment of the new local governments.
