

Sayyid Al-Hakeem receives Plasschaert, affirms Iraq's stability condition for regional stability



As the conclusion of her tenure in Baghdad approached, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of AL-Hikma National Movement, received Ms. Jeanine Plasschaert, Special Representative of the UN Secretary-General for Iraq on 5/5/2024, and expressed appreciation for the UN's efforts during the previous phase.
