

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: religious authority extinguishes discord flames when it expresses the honorable Sunni component “Anfusna”



In the district of Al-Khidr in the Samawah Governorate, at the guest place of Sheikh Aziz Marwi Al-Bu Ajada, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, met with a gathering of sheiks and dignitaries from the Al-Jawaber tribe and the clans of Muthanna.
