

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Dialogue and mutual understanding only possible solutions to resolve faction's disputes



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, welcomed the President of the Chinese People's Association for Peace and Disarmament, and expressed his support and appreciation for the association's efforts in promoting peace values, underscoring the importance of peace for the stability of nations and its importance for enabling the people to harness their resources.
