

Sayyid Al-Hakeem urges to focus on youth teams, invest capabilities and talents



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with the President of the Iraqi Football Association, Captain Adnan Dirjal, to discuss the Association's plans for developing football and achieving success.
