

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Lauds Iraq's Aid Campaign to Answer the Supreme Religious Authority's Call



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with the head of the Popular Mobilization Forces (PMF), Mr. Falih Al-Fayyadh, and commended the donation campaign initiated by the Iraqi people in response to the call of the Supreme Religious Authority. His Eminence reiterated the importance of safeguarding and building on the security achievements, which were made possible by the sacrifices of Iraqis from all backgrounds, and emphasized the need to establish lasting stability.
