

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Hussein Rituals Are Our Iraqi People Education and Awareness Institutions, Honor and Dignity Source



From the Alewian sacred city of Kufa, the capital of Imam Ali (peace be upon him), and the guesthouse of our esteemed brother, the servant of Imam Hussein (peace be upon him), Sayyid Abdullah Shubbar, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with a group of sheikhs and dignitaries from the city.
