

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Yazidi Community a Valuable Addition to Iraqi Society Beyond Numbers



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of Al-Hikma National Movement, discussed with Mr. Hazem Bek, the leader of the Yazidis in Iraq and the world, ways to support the Yazidi community in Iraq, facilitate the return of displaced individuals to their homes, and rebuild their cities. The meeting was attended by MP Mahma Khalil, the Vice President of the Christian Endowment, and the Prime Minister's Advisor for Yazidi Affairs.
