

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Receives Kirkuk Governor, Emphasizes Kirkuk Success Is Success for All of Iraq



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, received Kirkuk Governor, Mr. Rebwar Taha, accompanied by the Deputy Governor and a number of senior provincial officials. H.E. reaffirmed that Kirkuk represents a microcosm of Iraq, stating that success in Kirkuk signifies success for the entire country.
