

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets Al-Muthana Governor, Stresses Enhancing Services, Economic Development



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with the Governor of Al-Muthanna, Mr. Muhanad Al-Atabi, and discussed key issues concerning public affairs, service delivery, and development in the governorate.
