

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Receives Kurdistan Region President, Discusses Political Developments and Federal-KRG Relations



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met this evening with His Excellency Nechirvan Barzani, President of the Kurdistan Region of Iraq, to discuss the latest political developments in Iraq and the region, as well as the relationship between the federal government and the Kurdistan Regional Government (KRG).

During the meeting, Sayyid Al-Hakeem reiterated the importance of relying on official channels for dialogue and consultations between both sides. H.E. emphasized the need to achieve social justice through the equitable distribution of wealth.
