

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Discusses Iraqi, Regional Political Updates with Prime Minister, Lauds Iraq Approach to Deal with Challenges Without Involvement



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received His Sovereignty Prime Minister Mohammed Shia' Al-Sudani. During the meeting, they discussed the latest political and security developments in Iraq and the region, the challenges of the current phase, government obligations, the role of provincial councils, and efforts to support and expedite stalled projects.

Additionally, H.E. urged greater support for local governments by granting them the necessary authority and resources to enhance services and significant qualitative shift in their provinces.
