

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Receives Iranian Former Foreign Affairs Minister, Discusses Political Updates, Bilateral Ties



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received the Iranian Vice President for Strategic Affairs and former Minister of Foreign Affairs, Dr. Mohammad Javad Zarif, along with his accompanying delegation.
