

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets President El-Sisi, Commends Egypt's Support for Palestinian Cause



At the outset of His Eminence's visit to the Arab Republic of Egypt, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with His Excellency President Abdel Fattah El-Sisi.
