

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets Abu Al-Gheit, Discusses Strengthening Arab's Position Amid Challenges



At the Arab League headquarters, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, met with His Excellency Ahmed Abu Al-Gheit, Secretary-General of the Arab League.
