

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets Transportation Minister, Praises Ministry's Efforts in Serving Citizens, Developing Infrastructure



This morning, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met with His Excellency Minister of Transport, Mr. Razzaq Muhaibis.
