

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Receives Speaker Nabih Berri's Envoy, Lebanese Ambassador to Baghdad, Affirms Iraq's Enduring Support for Lebanon, Its People



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received Dr. Qabalan Qabalan, envoy of the Speaker of Parliament Nabih Berri, accompanied by the Lebanese Ambassador to Baghdad, Mr. Ali Adeeb Al-Habbhab.
