

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Discusses Women's Rights, Political Empowerment with “It’s Time for Iraqi Women” Initiative Delegation



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received a delegation from the “It’s Time for Iraqi Women” initiative to discuss the current status of Iraqi women, the protection of their political and social rights, and the importance of coordination between women-focused organizations and the Supreme Council for Iraqi Women.

His Eminence stressed the need to safeguard women’s representation and uphold their constitutional and legal rights, stating that empowering women is a source of real strength for Iraqi society.
