

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Commends Security Forces, Stresses Technological Advancement, Drug Control Priority



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, praised the outstanding security efforts that accompanied the Arab Summit in Baghdad during his meeting with Interior Minister Abdul Ameer Al-Shimmari. H.E. considered these efforts pivotal in showcasing Iraq's capability to host major international events securely.
