

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Receives Canadian Ambassador, Discusses Bilateral Ties, Political Updates



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received this morning the Ambassador of Canada to Iraq, H.E. Christopher David Bim. The meeting focused on the latest political developments in Iraq and the region, as well as the state of bilateral relations between Baghdad and Ottawa.

During the meeting, Sayyid Al-Hakeem emphasized the importance of strengthening Iraqi-Canadian relations and diversifying areas of cooperation in ways that serve the interests of both nations. H.E. stressed that the current phase calls for greater engagement and coordination with international partners who support Iraq's path to stability.
