

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets New Baghdad Governor, Stresses to Empower Local Governments, Enhance Public Services



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, received today in his office the newly elected Governor of Baghdad, Mr. Atwan Al-Atwani, in the presence of Baghdad Provincial Council President Mr. Ammar Al-Hamdani and several council members. H.E. congratulated Mr. Al-Atwani on earning the council's confidence and assuming leadership of the capital, wishing him success in fulfilling his responsibilities.

His Eminence emphasized the importance of granting local governments their full constitutional and legal authorities, noting that provincial councils are a foundational pillar in delivering services as they are the first point of contact with citizens.
