

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Discusses Political Developments with Al-Saedi, Stresses Southern Provinces Support, Services Five Pillars Advancement



During a meeting with Professor Jawad Raheem Al-Saedi, Head of the Jihad and Construction Movement, His Eminence Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, recalled the long record of jihadist sacrifices in confronting dictatorship, offering prayers of mercy for the martyrs of that era.
