

Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Iranian Ambassador Discuss Strengthening Bilateral Relations, Emphasize Elections as Key to Sustainable Stability



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of of the National State Powers' Alliance, received on Sunday, October 5, 2025, H.E. Mohammad Kazem Al-Sadegh, Ambassador of the Islamic Republic of Iran to Baghdad.
