

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Meets President Barzani, Describes Elections as Historic Opportunity, Stresses Dialogue to Resolve Baghdad–Kurdistan Issues



As part of his visit to the Kurdistan Region, Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met on Tuesday, October 7, 2025, with H.E. President Masoud Barzani. The meeting discussed the latest developments in Iraq and the nature of the upcoming political entitlements.
