

Sayyid Al-Hakeem: Iraq's Stability Stems from People's Sacrifices, Chance for Constructive International Cooperation



Sayyid Ammar Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers Alliance, met in Baghdad on the evening of Thursday, October 16, 2025, with His Excellency Mr. Daniel Krüper, Ambassador of Germany to Iraq, as part of His Eminence's ongoing engagement with diplomatic missions operating in the country.
