

## Sayyid Al-Hakeem Discusses Political Updates, Strengthening Economic Cooperation with Japan's Foreign Affairs Ministry



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received in his Baghdad office Mr. Nagaoka Kansuke, Director of the Middle East and North Africa Department at Japan's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Monday evening, December 1, 2025. The meeting was attended by the Japanese Ambassador to Baghdad, His Excellency Mr. Akira Ando.

During the meeting, His Eminence reviewed developments in Iraq's political landscape following the recent parliamentary elections.
