

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Affirms Fair Representation for Christian Community, Calls Special Voter Registry



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received on Wednesday evening, 7 January 2026, at His office in Baghdad, a delegation from the Christian Suyana Bloc led by MP Kildo Ramzi Oghanna.

The meeting reviewed the conditions of the Christian component in Iraq, stressing that parliamentary quota representation must truly reflect the component's legitimate entitlement and free choices, ensuring fair representation and safeguarding the genuine will of voters.

H.E. renewed the call for establishing a dedicated voter registry to guarantee that the Christian vote reaches its rightful representatives.
