

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Affirms Components Partnership Importance to Preserve Political System, Country's Stability



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, received at His office in Baghdad on Thursday morning, 29 January 2026, the Secretary-General of Muttahidoon Party, Mr. Osama Al-Nujaifi, along with his accompanying delegation.

The meeting addressed developments in Iraq's political scene and the wider region, with H.E. emphasizing the importance of genuine partnership among all components in assuming national responsibilities and safeguarding the political system in a manner that reinforces the country's stability and sovereignty.
