

Sayyid Al-Hakeem Affirms Islamic Cooperation Organization Role Importance, Calls of Islamic Stance Unity



His Eminence Sayyid Al-Hakeem, Head of the National State Powers' Alliance, on Thursday morning, 5 February 2026, met with Mr. Mohammed Sameer Al-Naqshbandi, Director of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation's office in Iraq.
